2. Student Well-Being & Safety

We appeal to parents to continue exercising social responsibility and not send your child to school should he/she be unwell or experience any flu-like or infectious symptoms (even mild ones). You are advised to take your child to seek medical attention, and he/she should only return to school when he/she has fully recovered. Kindly ensure that you follow up with the Form Teacher/s on the reason for absence and submission of valid supporting documents.

3. Turnstile Installation Update

Turnstiles have been installed at Gate 1A (the side gate adjacent to the Main Gate) and Gate 3 (the gate beside the bus stop). These mechanical gates feature revolving horizontal arms fixed to a vertical post, permitting entry/exit to authorised personnel only. They will be operational in Term 3 during off-peak dismissal periods for the time being until enhanced card access control systems are in place.

4. Primary 3 Digital Drama Show: Building Mental Resilience, Empathy and Peer Support

Primary 3 students will be viewing a digital drama show followed by facilitated class discussions. The programme aims to help students understand the importance of mental resilience and develop greater awareness of their emotions and challenges. They will also learn appropriate ways to support peers who may require help, while recognising the importance of empathy, care and respect towards others. Through the discussions and activities, students will be encouraged to build confidence in contributing positively to a caring and supportive school community.

5. Racial Harmony Day

Our school will commemorate Racial Harmony Day (RHD) on **20 July, Monday**. This year's theme for RHD, *Our People, Our Tapestry*, focuses on how different cultural threads – representing our unique identities, traditions, beliefs and practices – come together to form a rich and colourful multicultural tapestry. By listening, learning, and showing respect towards different ethnic and religious communities, we can keep our multicultural society strong, united and harmonious.

As part of the commemoration, your child/ward will engage in a series of school activities that encourage embracing diversity and building friendships. Students are to wear their Lead with LPRIDE green t-shirt and black school shoes on that day.

Do partner us in engaging your child/ward in conversations at home to deepen his/her understanding of the rich cultures, traditions and experiences of the different races in Singapore.

6. National Day

We will be celebrating National Day on **7 August, Friday**. This year's National Day theme *Majulah Singapura, Go Beyond!* captures our Singapore Spirit and our enduring aspiration to keep moving forward. *Go Beyond!* is our call to action to do better for Singapore and Singaporeans, and to show care and concern for one another and our wider community.
