GENERAL SCHOOL INFORMATION

School Hours

1. The new school term will commence on Thursday, 2 January 2025 for the P1 students only. Refer to page 8 of this booklet for the First Day of School programme for P1s.
2. Morning Assembly will start promptly at 7.30 a.m. Students are strongly encouraged to report to the hall/classroom 15 minutes before the start of school to help them settle down and be prepared for the day's learning and activities. Students should bring along a storybook for silent reading every day.
3. Dismissal time is staggered for the different levels. The dismissal time for the P1 students is scheduled at 1.30 p.m. on Monday to Thursday and 1.15 p.m. on Friday.

4. Nametags are required on **both** the school uniforms and the PE T-shirts. The nametag is to be sewn approximately 1.5 cm above the school logo.
5. P1 students will be wearing a **plastic name tag** for the first 2 weeks of school for easy identification and for staff to provide help when necessary. The name tag will be given out by the teachers on the first day of school.
6. Students should wear their PE attire on days when they have PE Lessons and the Programme for Active Learning (PAL). Six periods (1.5hr) each week are set aside for PAL lessons where your child will engage in different activities to learn socio-emotional competencies.

7. Your child will be given a timetable by their Form Teachers by the end of the first week of school. Please teach your child to pack his/her bag and bring items/books according to the timetable.

Buddy Arrangements for Recess Breaks

8. Primary 4 buddies will assist P1 students from 3 to 9 Jan 2025. Teachers will also join the P1 recess breaks in Week 1 to help students adjust and support them towards independence.

13. We kindly request that you prepare the following documents required for updating your child/ward's records and submit them to the General Office on 2 Jan 2025: medical reports, letter of undertaking, court order for childcare arrangements, etc.

14. During dismissal, teachers will escort all students to the designated dismissal venues (see below) based on your Parents Gateway response in late December 2024.

Day 2 Onwards (from 3 January 2025)

15. From the second day onwards, please drop off your child/ward at the foyer. Our student leaders will be there to accompany your child/ward to the hall or classroom.

P1 Orientation Programme (3-10 January 2025)

16. Our orientation programme, themed “Lakeside PRIDE,” will introduce school routines, foster friendships, and provide an enjoyable learning experience. Activities include learning the National Anthem, school routines, and interactive themed sessions across subjects.

Collection of School Books

17. The collection of workbooks and exercise books will be staggered to ensure that students’ school bags are not too heavy.



18. The form teachers will inform the parents on the schedule for the collection of the books.
19. Students should bring their pencil case, Student Handbook and Homework file every day.
20. To allow for the ease of collection and identification of materials, please label your child/ward’s books, files, water bottle and stationery items with his/her name and class.

Healthy Meals in Schools Programme

21. The school has embarked on the Healthy Meals in Schools Programme (HMSP) since 2013. PARENT GATEWAY ONBOARDING GUIDE

22. Parents Gateway is a mobile app developed by MOE to support parents' involvement in their child's educational journey. The app enables parents to receive information from the school and perform a range of administrative functions, including granting consent for school programmes/activities, booking of Parent-Teacher Meeting slots and declaring travel plans during school terms.

23. Resources will also be shared to support parents and prepare your child for this transition, as well as provide important administrative instructions and announcements on the following:

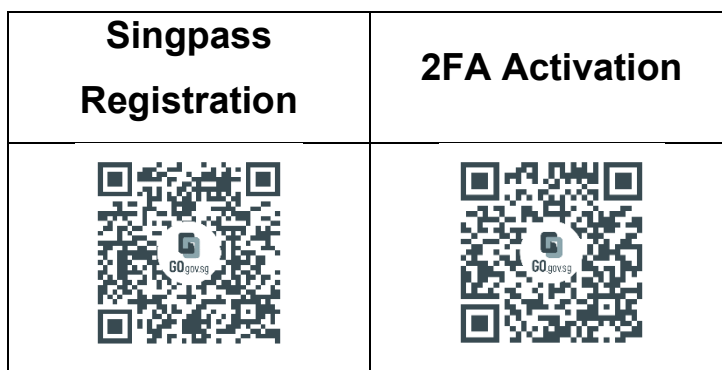
- (i) the start of school preparation process

One-Time Onboarding

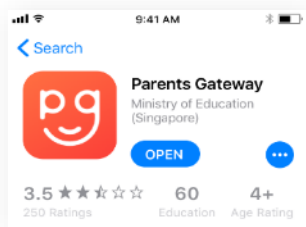
Step 1 – Singpass Registration and 2FA Setup

Step 2 – Download Parents Gateway Mobile App

- Open the Apple App Store, Google Play Store or Huawei App Gallery on your mobile phone.
- Search for the ‘Parents Gateway’ mobile app or scan the QR code below.



- Download and install the app on your phone.
- Enable ‘**Allow Notifications**’ to receive push notifications.
